There has been quite the kerfuffle happening at the state capitol recently and I just want to draw your attention to it. The bishops of our state have been keeping an eye on recent legislation called the Equal Rights Amendment looking to make a change to our state constitution. Bishop Zielinski told us last week at our clergy meetings that this is something pretty awful as it is attacking many things, especially our religious freedom. Bishop Barron is describing it as an imposition of the sexual revolution on the people of our beloved state of Minnesota. He highlights two things in his video which are abortion rights and the imposition of gender ideology and experimenting on young kids sexuality by hormone treatments and surgical procedures. A group that is not protected in this proposed legislation are religious people. Save the Date: Our largest fundraiser of the school year is coming up on Friday May 31, 2024 from 5 PM- Midnight. This year marks our fourth annual "A Night in Havana" event. It is an adults only night out with many fun ways to entertain yourself for the evening! The event is free to attend and open to the public. It takes place in the parking lot of the church and school. This year, we will have a food truck that is available to purchase your meal, you can purchase drinks at our own Havana bar, bid on the silent and live auction items, purchase raffle tickets, and enjoy free live music by local bands Chris and Chris and The Blue Ringers. Come and join us for this fun fundraising event! All proceeds benefit St. Raphael Catholic School. The committee began sending out sponsor letters in March and has been following up with them. K-6 Elementary School-Now Enrolling: We are now enrolling students going into K-6th grade for the 2024-2025 school year. We offer a comprehensive faith-based education which includes daily prayer, weekly Mass, formal religion classes, language arts, math, science, social studies, technology, physical education, music, and art. Preschool-Now Enrolling: Although we will have a different teacher, we plan to keep doing what we do best at St. Raphael Catholic School--bringing students to a deeper relationship with Jesus while providing them with excellent education!!! I am confident we will find an excellent candidate and continue the legacy of an awesome preschool program at St. Raphael. Registration is now open for the Little Panthers Preschool program (3 year olds) and our Kindergarten Readiness program (4 year olds). Our Little Panthers program meets on Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 8-11 AM and our Kindergarten Readiness program meets on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 8-11 AM. The cost is \$13.50 per day for each of our preschool programs. Students who are eligible for our program must be 3 years old before September 1, 2024 (Little Panthers) and 4 years old by September 1, 2024 (Kindergarten Readiness.) Students must also be potty trained and be able to use the bathroom independently. To register for the 2024-2025 school year, stop in to the school office to get a registration form and return it with your \$25 registration fee. 
HOW SHOULD I RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION? First and for most you should approach the reception of Holy Communion with a soul free from all mortal sin.

The Catholic church teaches that you may receive the Sacred Host in two ways, with both you should bow first and then to receive Holy Communion in the hand respond "Amen", extend your hands, one directly over the other, as the Sacred Host is deposited. If possible, keep your hands flat and wait until the priest/deacon/EMHC deposits the Sacred Host before reaching for it. Please do not reach for the Sacred Host but rather receive it into your hand. Avoid holding your hands up too high or too low. Holy Communion on the tongue should be received by keeping your hands folded, respond "Amen", tip your head back as you open your mouth and slightly stick out your tongue so that the Host may be placed upon it.


After you receive Holy Communion you should take a step to the side, make the sign of the cross and then process on your way back to the pew.

If the chalice is present you should approach the chalice, bow slightly, respond "Amen" and receive the chalice. Take a small sip and return the chalice to the EMHC, make the sign of the cross and return to your pew. If you choose not to receive from the chalice be sure to bow slightly to the chalice as you pass by.




